This Week's Deployment Update

This week's deployment fixes resolved the following issues:



Applicant Portal Enhancements:

- Resolved issues preventing some users from progressing through the Emergency Contact section in core questions.
- Improved conditional logic in Texas Residency section for applicants.

Admin Portal Enhancements:

- Updated schools and majors CSV download.
- Updated to clear free text in Family Obligations when selections are changed.
- Resolved EDI issues regarding employment/internship data across all application types.

Counselor Portal Enhancements:

- Updated counselor and district counselor permission to expire 1 calendar year after date of authorization.
- Improved search function for queries.
- Updated data to display high school students in grade 9-12.

Troubleshooting Tips of the Week

Admin Portal users:

As a reminder, there are three main types of role authorizations within the Admin Portal: Gatekeeper, THECB Representative, and ApplyTexas Technical Team member. Previous roles such as Application Viewer and Executive Updater are now consolidated under the Gatekeeper role, with the ability to customize permissions.
