ApplyTexas Maintenance Updates & Required Actions

ApplyTexas Partners,

We are pleased to announce two upcoming deployment windows that will continue to enhance the functionality of ApplyTexas. Below are the details of the upcoming deployments, a summary of our latest system improvements, and an invitation to our upcoming webinar briefings.

Upcoming deployment schedule

Tuesday, June 25: We will be deploying the following fixes:

- Enable the CSV/JSON download buttons, include user's email in the 'download results' file
- Modify the school search logic so applicants will be eligible to apply to two-year institutions for additional application types (international undergrad, international transfer, transfer, visiting student, readmit)

Note: 2-year institutions will be required to take additional action following this fix. Please look out for further instructions via email tomorrow.

- Update the conditional logic for gender and phone number requirements to resolve EDI discrepancies

- Remove duplicate language and college history records in the admin portal

Thursday, June 27: Further deployments will focus on the following:

- Address additional EDI issues
- Update international zip code validations/error messages
- Update screener results for non-citizen applicants with visas
- Add additional columns in the CSV and JSON download results to match legacy behavior
- Address remaining bugs on application details view so there aren't any code references

Please look out for communication after each deployment summarizing the success of the fixes.

- **Expected downtime:** ApplyTexas will be temporarily inaccessible during this period.
