- · Activation of CSV/JSON download buttons

- Enhancements to school search logic to support more applicant types
- Updates to conditional logic for gender and phone number requirements
- Removal of duplicate records in the Admin portal

Thursday, June 27:

- Resolution of additional EDI discrepancies, including the emergency contact section and email address entered by the applicant in the core questions contact section
- Updates to include alpha numeric zip codes for international addresses
- Enhancements to screener results for non-citizen applicants
- Addition of new columns in download results to align with legacy behavior
